SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

DEADLINE: February 10, 2022

1. A minimum of one \$1,000.00 scholarship is available.
2. The applicant must be an Adult or Junior member of the Ohio Society. There is no restriction on the residence of the applicant.
3. During the school year 2021-2022, the applicant must be enrolled in the first year or later of a college or university program leading to a bachelor's or advanced degree.
4. The original essay must be written and signed by the applicant. The topic is: **"CONFLICT"**. Dealing with: What were the conflicts, that existed between The Church of England and those who were members of Separatist churches.
5. The judges will consider the following rubric:

Essay: Content (organization, clarity of thought, grammar, & punctuation)	30%
Reality of possible problems to be faced	10%
Reality of suggested solution to such problems	10%
Quality of leadership techniques to be used	10%
Letters of recommendation	40%
6. Please use a size 12 font, to a maximum of (4) four single side pages.
7. Only original documents will be accepted.
8. The award may be granted **only** twice to the same applicant.
9. The scholarship need not be given if the Committee decides there are no qualified applicants.
10. The winner(s) will be notified by late March of 2022 and will be invited to present the winning essay(s) at the Annual Assembly held in May. Expanded information about the winner(s) may be printed in the next issue of the *"Buckeye Mayflower"*.
11. The award will be paid directly to the student by the Ohio Society upon receiving proof that the student is enrolled for the next school year.
12. An application for the scholarship is enclosed. The blank application may be copied.
13. The Application & Essay must be **Postmarked by February 10, 2022** to be considered for a scholarship.
